# Resolution 5 (AC-14/17-18)

# 1. Prof. V. Balamohan Das, Member, Governing Body suggested the following

- a. A resolution may be moved in the Academic Council to request the Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education for permitting the college to offer the second language courses in the fourth semester also.
  - Also suggested that in the covering letter it is to be mentioned that If the Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education does not respond with in the dead line then it is deemed to be considered as approved.
- In the Business of the Academic Council the word "shall be approved" may be replaced with "to be approved".
- c. Every student and teacher of Gayatri Vidya Parishad College for Degree and PG Courses should know about the Indian culture and value system and it is to be included in the syllabi of the curriculum. If necessary, orientation programmes are to be organized regularly to the teachers on these issues.
- d. Students of the College are to be encouraged to participate and actively involve in the community services to help the society.

Principal responded to the suggestions and informed the council that the suggestions will be considered for implementation.

Resolution: Academic Council has resolved to request the Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education to permit the College to offer second language in the fourth semester also.

# 2. Prof. P. S. Avadhani, Principal, A.U. College of Engineering (Autonomous) Expert from the outside the College suggested the following

- a. He suggested that the list of books mentioned in the syllabus are to be presented in the standard formula.
- All the activities of the College must be recorded and displayed.
   He also mentioned that e-mail address and website address are to be displayed in the premises of the College and to be printed in the brochures, hand book and the posters.

Principal responded and informed the council that necessary measures will be initiated to implement the suggestions.

# 3. Prof. K. Ramji, Department of Mechanical Engineering Nominee of Vice Chancellor, Andhra University enquired about

- a. The training activities, placements, on line courses, cultural activities, outreach programmes and community services of the students and the data base on alumni and their involvement in the college.
  - b. He also suggested that the students of Gayatri Vidya Parishad must be different from the students of other institutions.
  - c. He also suggested that the data base of the students who were not selected in the campus placements is also to be maintained.

Principal responded to the queries and elaborately explained about the activities of the students of the College on the issues raised. He also said that the data base of the alumni is already being maintained and steps will be taken to strengthen the data base.

4. Prof. K. Siva Krishna Rao, Professor, Department of Electronics and Electrical Engineering, Nominee of Vice Chancellor, Andhra University enquired about availability of Physical Directors and facilities for Games and Sports

Principal responded and explained that one Physical Director for each campus is recruited and the facilities for Games and Sports are provided by the college and also informed that students of the College are winning prizes in the intercollegiate, inter university and zonal level games and sports.

5. Prof. V. Subrahmanya Sastry, Former Professor of Telugu, Andhra University suggested that college should organize cultural and literary programmes once in a month to help the students in understanding the Indian culture and value system.

Principal responded saying steps will be taken to implement the suggestions.

 Prof. P.S. Rao, Vice President, Gayatri Vidya Parishad appealed the university authorities to scrap the unit system in the syllabus and also in the examination for the engineering students. 7. Dr. V. Chandra Sekhar, Principal, Dr. V. S. Krishna Govt Degree College suggested that a record of the list of students were selected for civil services to be maintained and suggested to organize training classes for the students appearing for competitive exams.

Principal responded to the suggestions and promised to take measures to implement the suggestions.
