2. adding a MOOC course at a lower credit band to accommodate the number of credits in the semester so as to encourage students towards self-learning.


Other Resolutions:

7. Single valuation of semester end examination papers for all post graduate courses(subjects) shall be performed from this academic year (2023-24).



The following changes were suggested.

- In III semester, for the title of the subject "Strength of Materials", the UNIT- II title Bending Moments and Shear Forces has to be renamed as "Shear force and Bending moment Diagrams" and a topic "Beams subjected to uniformly varying loads" has to be added in this unit. The topics under the UNIT-V have to be completely changed and the topics related to thin cylinders and spherical shells have to be added and then unit title has to be renamed as "Thin Cylinders and Spherical shells".
- In III semester for the title of the subject "Manufacturing Processes", the topic casting defects- testing and inspection has to be included in UNIT- II. In UNIT III a topic HERF (High energy rate formation) is to be included under the section 'drawing'. It was also suggested that in all the units wherever the scope to learn the defects in manufacturing processes have to be included.
- In III semester, in IoT lab, two more exercises have to be added related to practical application.
- In IV semester, for the title of the subject 'Kinematics of Machinery' has to be renamed as **Theory of Machines - I** without changing the content of the syllabus.
- In IV semester, for the subject "Metal cutting and Machine tools", in the UNIT – III it was suggested to include the topics related to jigs and fixtures.
- In IV semester, for the subject "Fluid Mechanics and Hydraulic Machines", in UNIT- III the topics related to Compressible fluid flow have to be removed completely.
- In IV semester, for the subject "Metallurgy and Material Science", in UNIT- V the topics related composite materials and nano materials have to be incorporated in place of topics related to powder metallurgy. In UNIT –II a topic of solid solutions has to be included.
- In IV semester in Manufacturing Technology Lab – I, two more experiments related to sand testing have to be added.
- In IV semester in Fluid Mechanics and Machinery Lab, an experiment related to verification of Bernoulli's theorem has to be included in the list of experiments.
- In IV semester in Skill Oriented Course titled CAD Lab, two more exercises have to be included.
