# 1. Examination System of the College

#### a) Academic Calendar:

# b) Scope of Exam Policy:

At present the college offers Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and adopted grading system for all courses. The College conducts examinations for the students who are on regular rolls.

# 2 .Process of conducting Examinations:

# Question Paper Setting and Confidentiality:

The model question papers, syllabus, list of names of Paper setters (minimum three experts) are approved in Board of Studies of each department. HODs submits the copies to the examination cell with the due approval of the principal.

# Process of Paper Setting:

After receiving the approved model question papers, syllabus, list of names of Paper setters, the Assistant Controllers of Examination sends the same to the approved paper setters confidentially either physically or through email (by protecting password) with the consent of Controller of Examinations, for preparation of question papers to all the UG, Engineering &Technology and PG courses. The examination section maintains at least 4 sets of question papers.

After receiving the sealed question papers from the paper setters, they are handed over to the Controller of Examinations and the duly signed covers, will be kept under the safe custody.

# Appointment of Observers:

The college nominates senior faculty as Observers to visit the Examination Centers at various campuses with the conduct of all UG, Engineering &Technology and PG Examinations. The Observers submits the report to the concern Chief Superintendent, then it is sent to the Controller of Examinations, (UG&PG) to take appropriate action on the Malpractice Cases booked if any.

# Provision for Students with Back logs:

After conduct of Regular and Supplementary Examinations the following additional provisions are made to conduct the Examinations for the benefit of the Students in order to complete their Courses.

- Instant Examinations: The College conducts Instant Examination to the Regular candidates who fail in one subject in Final Year Semesters in all the UG, Engineering &Technology and PG Courses in every academic year. The results are declared within 10 days.
- Special Examinations: The Special Examinations are conducted as a special case to the relieved Batch Candidates who fails in one or two subjects in the respective disciplines for the purpose of employment and admission into further studies basing on the requests made by the candidates and their Parents as a special Case and the results is declared those candidates within 10 days.
- Special Drive Examinations: The Special Drive Examinations for UG, Engineering &Technology and PG is conducted once in every two years for the old batch Students.


