**ANNUAL REPORT
FROM JUNE 2020- JUNE 2021**

HIGH LIGHTS

- The College has been granted Extension of Autonomous status by UGC up to 2025-2026.
- 2 Post Graduate programmes in Engineering and Technology 1) M.Tech in Structural Engineering 2) M.Tech in Computer Science and Technology have been introduced in 2020-2021.
- B.Voc. Programme in Mobile Communication has been introduced from 2020-21
- 21 faculty from different departments of the College have been identified as Research guides and a total of 66 candidates allotted for PhD guidance under the Trans disciplinary Research Hub – Andhra University.
- Department of Management Studies has undertaken two consultancy projects 1) for ITC on Solid Waste Management. 2) for NTPC on Social Audit of School Toilets

ADMISSIONS

- Admissions during the academic year 2020-2021 have been delayed. The process concluded in February 2021. For the first time admissions in UG Programmes was also done in online mode by APSCHE. Except in the new programme – B.Voc in Mobile Communications, in all other UG programmes, the full component of sanctioned intake has been admitted.

In Engineering branches also the admissions are good except in Civil and Mechanical branches. However in M.Tech admissions have been disappointing.

All other PG programmes admissions were full except in M.Sc Computer Science and MHRM. **(Annexure-I)**

- 20% reduction in syllabus has been adopted for this semester (due to Covid-19) as suggested by the UGC, for all undergraduate programmes i.e. B.Sc., B.Com.,B.B.A., B.C.A. and all B.Tech programmes as well as post graduate programmes of M.B.A., M.C.A., M.H.R.M., M.Sc Computer Science and M.Sc Organic Chemistry with the approval of respective Boards of Studies and same has been ratified by the Academic Council.
- For the admitted batch 2020-2021, all UG Programmes including B.Tech there is a major restructuring of syllabus with greater focus on Skill Development courses. For Engineering Programmes internships have been made mandatory. The class work has been in a blended format with Online/Offline classes ensuring that only 1/3 of the total students are on campus at any given point of time.

RESULTS AT A GLANCE

As you are aware the College is run under autonomous stream and the continuous evaluation method implemented in the examination process is very stringent and extra

care is taken at every step. All the internal exams have been in online mode . Wherever possible, labs and viva voce examinations have also been done in online mode.

This year at the undergraduate level the pass percentage in Commerce is 80.2, in Science it is 77, in Computer application it is 71.11 and in Management studies it is 87.

The pass percentage in P.G. Courses is MBA-83.11, MCA-98, M.Sc. Computer Science-90, M.H.R.M-100 and M.Sc organic Chemistry- 88. The pass percentage of Engineering is 43.34. **(Annexure-II)**

However all the successful students secured a high cumulative grade point average (CGPA)

Final exams for all UG Programmes were conducted last week for 2019-2021 batch, including 2018-2021 B. Tech batch. For the PG Programmes exams are going on now. All Covid-19 Protocols have been strictly followed.

PLACEMENTS

There are Placement Coordinators from each programme who have organized training programmes for enhancing employability skills of students and helped them prepare for placement drives. Career guidance has also been provided with support from external agencies. There is a Skill Development Centre established by National Skill Development Council – Andhra Pradesh, which is organizing Skill Development programme to UG Students. The renewed memorandum of understanding with TCS and good rapport with Professional bodies like CII, Yi, NIPM, CSE and Companies like UPTEC, Idea labs Limited, E2 Labs, Inventrax, Siya Softicon Private Limited and Dr. Reddy Labs , helped us immensely in the process of placing the students in different organizations.

The Department of Mechanical Engineering has renewed the MoU with CEMS (Centre of Excellence in Maritime and Shipbuilding), Visakhapatnam to provide training and placement to students.

Similarly MCA Department has signed an MoU with Inventrax for training and placement of Computer Science students.

204 students are placed to date. 66 companies have recruited from our Campus. Average package has been 3.4 lakhs and highest pay 7.10 lakhs per annum.

ECE department signed MoU with Maven Silicon to train students in VLSI domain.

MoU with CEEP (Competitive Exams Empowerment Programme) Training and Consultancy to prepare our students for competitive exams. **(Annexure – III)**

RECRUITMENT STAFF

Generally the attrition rate of our College is relatively low, but this year the numbers have gone up. 11 teaching staff have left the College. Most of the vacancies have been filled

up. Two members in PG programmes, ten members in Engineering and four members of non-teaching staff are newly inducted into the Gayatri family. All the above recruitments, including the internal selections have been done by duly constituted Selection Committees with subject experts from Andhra University. In this connection, I request the honorable members to ratify these promotions and appointment of newly selected faculty members.

Almost all the Departments of the College have arranged Guest Lectures on various contemporary topics for students and faculty. A few virtual tours of companies have also been organized. NTPC Simhadri , Aurobindo Pharmaceuticals, Granules Omnicem were amongst these. These guided tours and interaction with experts from Industry have helped the students understand the practical component of the workplace. **(Annexure – VIII)**

FEE REIMBURSEMENT

- All the eligible students of Under Graduate programmes including Engineering, who applied, have been sanctioned fee reimbursement by the respective social welfare departments under the scheme of JVD (Jagananna Vidya Deevena). An amount of Rs.1,33,51,500/- (Rupees One Crore, Thirty Three lakhs Fifty One thousand Five Hundred Only) was disbursed among 1974 students to their mother accounts in the month of March as first installment of fee reimbursement for the current academic year.
- From the year 2020-2021, fee reimbursement scheme for PG students has been stopped. Fee reimbursement is still pending for the previous academic year 2019-2020 for PG students. **(Annexure – XII)**

In this context I would like to draw your attention to the fact that fees payments have been delayed greatly because of delay in academic schedule and also government's fee reimbursement not released on time. Now funds have started flowing in.
